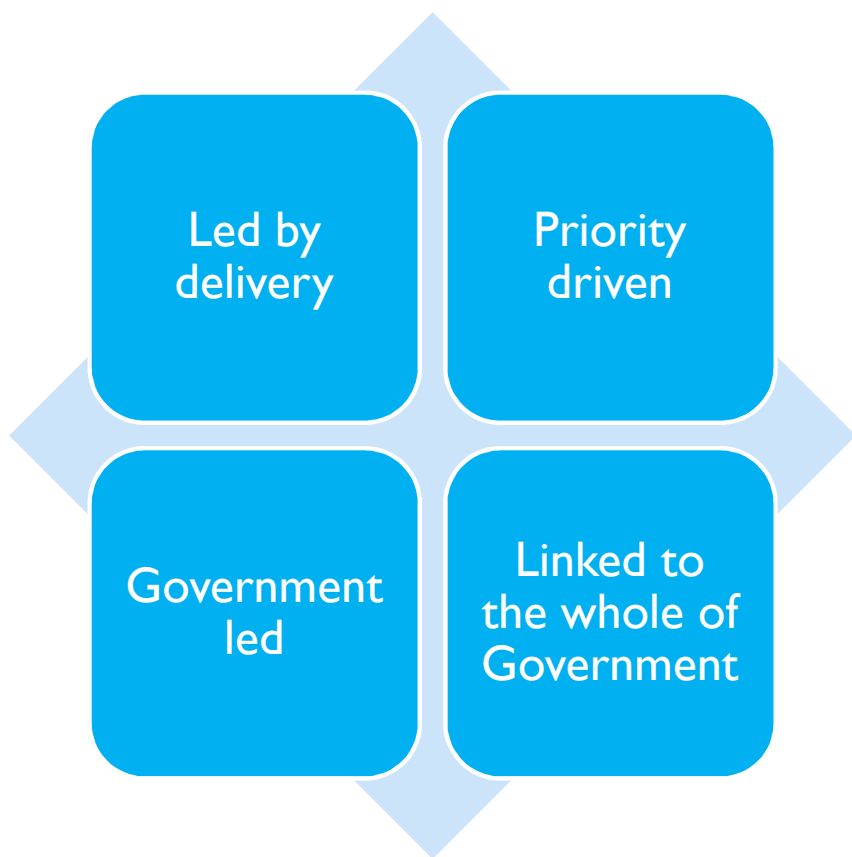

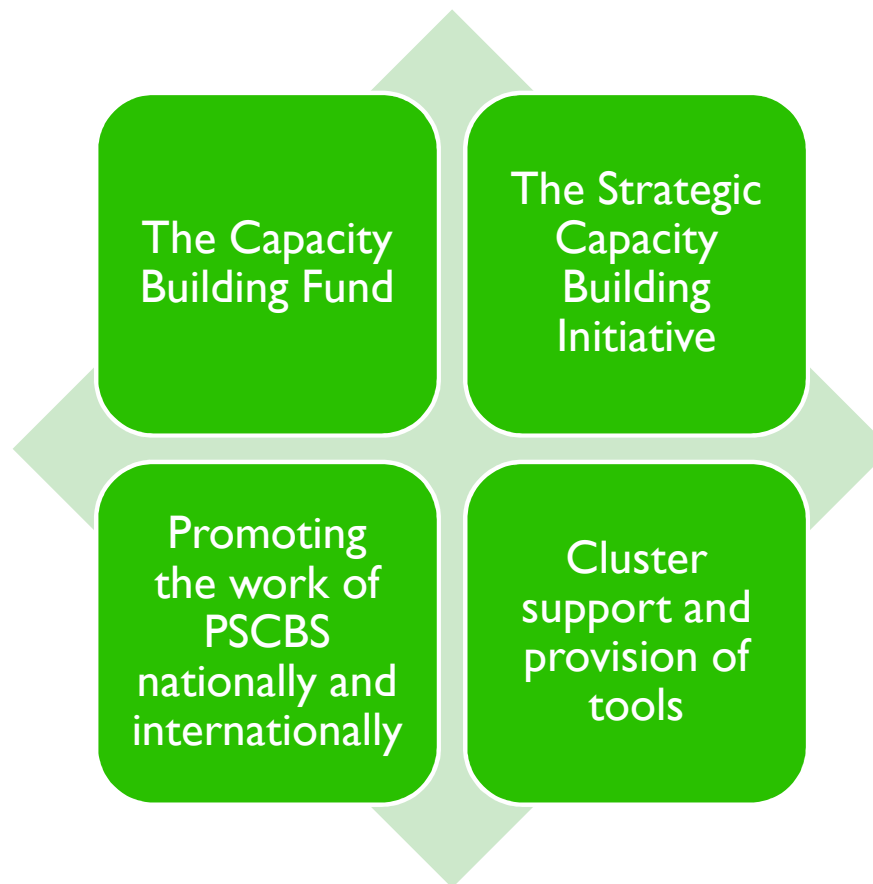


PSCBS is driving Strategic Capacity building in Rwanda

The Capacity Building Fund has been developing



A sensitisation workshop was held to introduce the Fund to key stakeholders

- ▶ Strategic Guidelines and Procedures Manual have been issued
- ▶ 70% will be directly aligned to strategic priorities set by the annual national leadership retreat
- ▶ 3 cluster specialists will be supporting each cluster and the relevant MDAs in developing capacity building plans



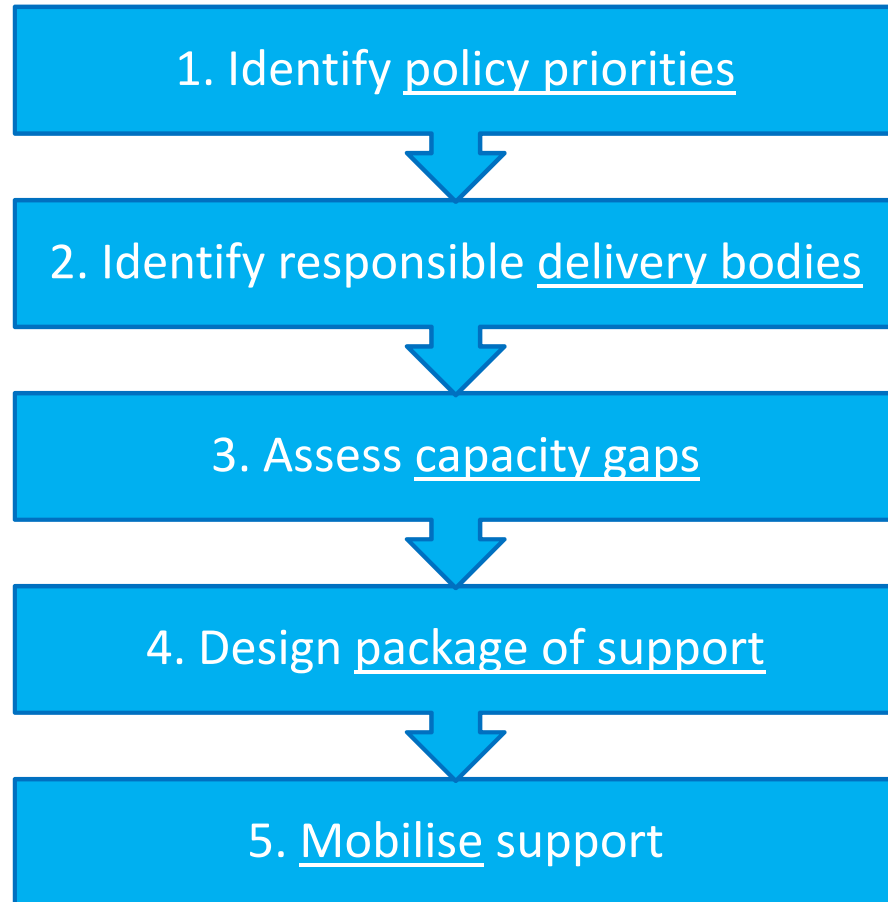
In 2011 we are driving forward a number of major projects

- ▶ In addition to our ongoing programmes, in the first quarter of 2011, we are:
 - ▶ Working with Ministries and Delivery Agencies to mainstream capacity building in the delivery of National Leadership Retreat priorities
 - ▶ Producing harmonised capacity building tools
 - ▶ Publishing the first ever Annual State of Capacity Building report for Rwanda, with support from the World Bank
 - ▶ Hosting the 20th Anniversary of the African Capacity Building Foundation on the 8th – 9th February at the Serena Hotel

Framework as outlined in last DPCG

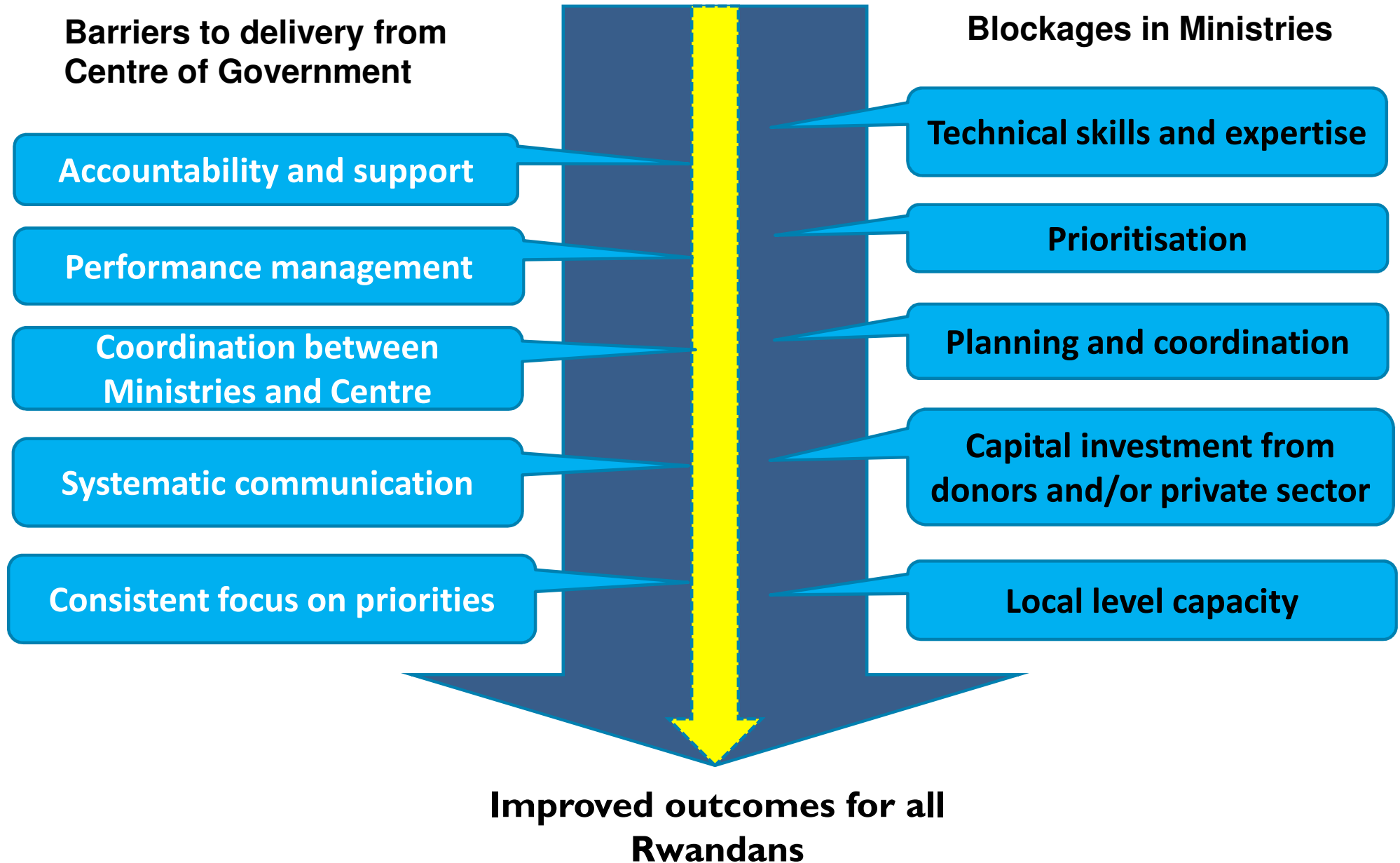


Timeline for implementation



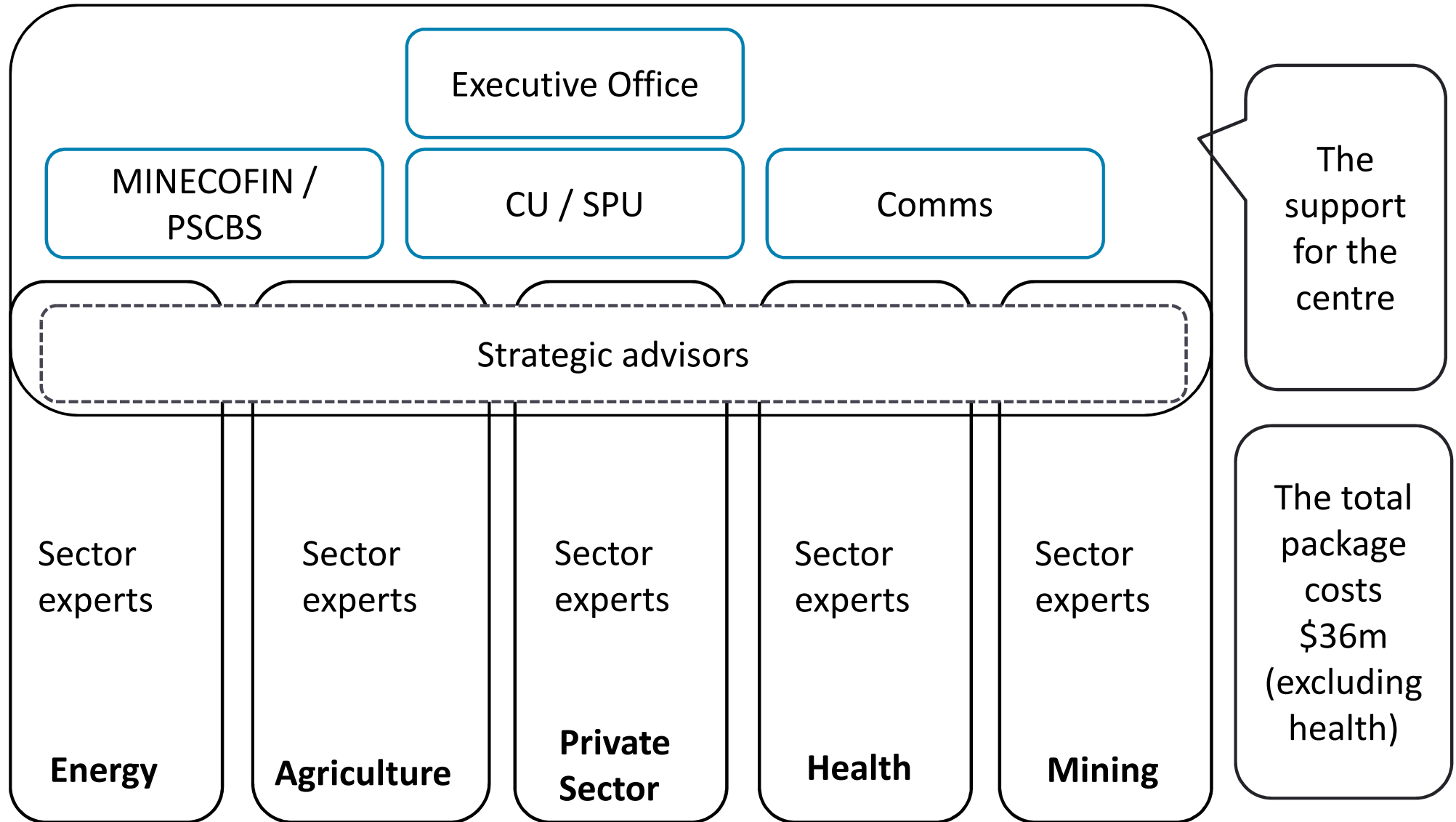
