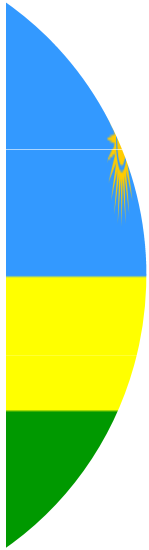

□ **Average GDP growth 2006 – 2010: 8.4%**



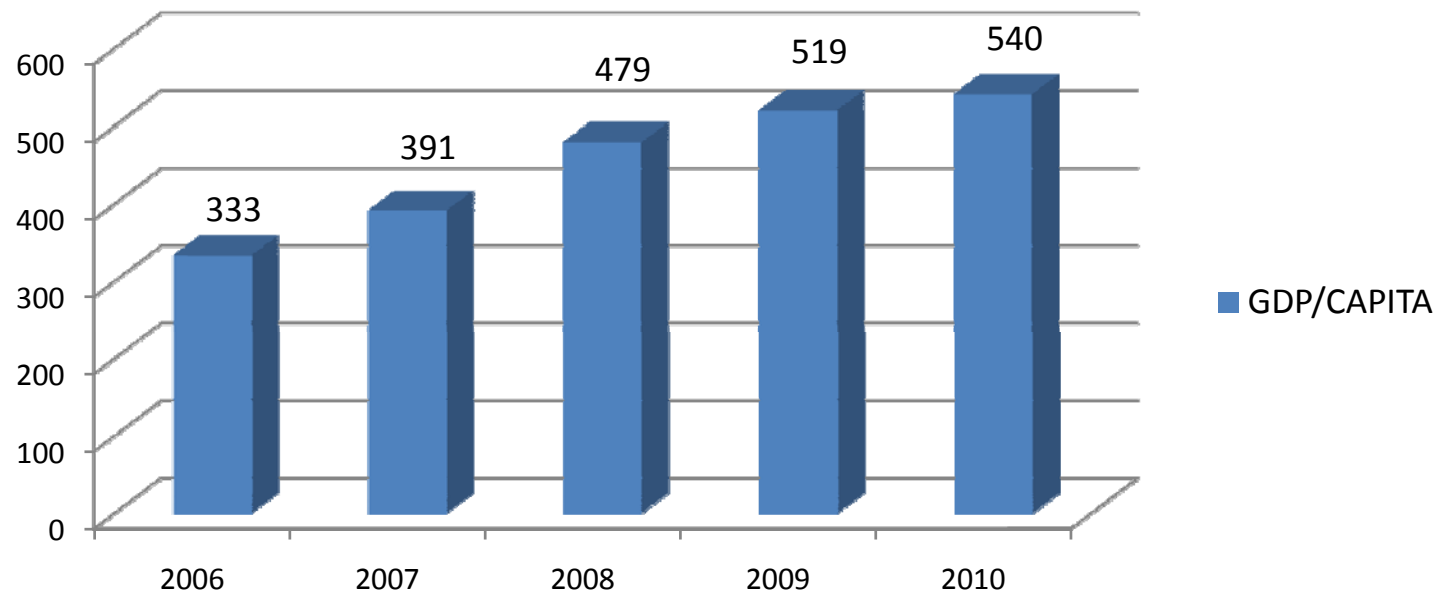


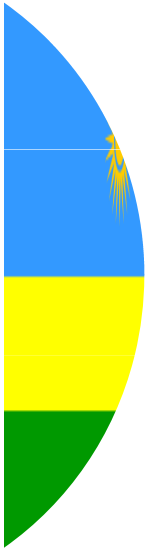

2006 - 2010**

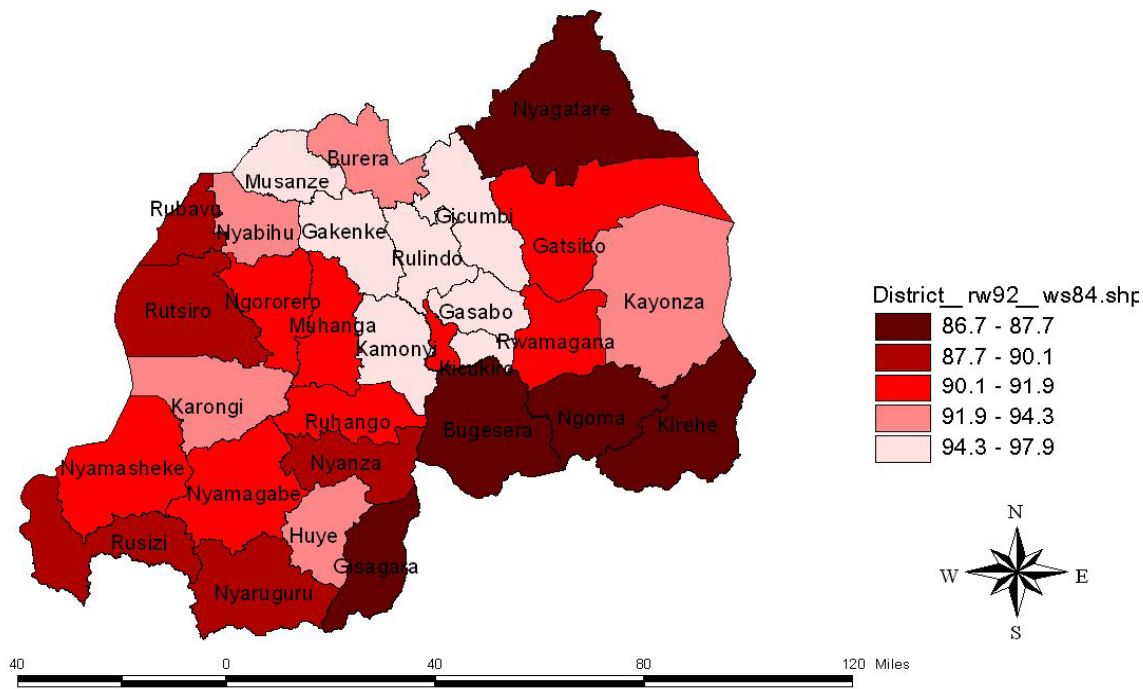




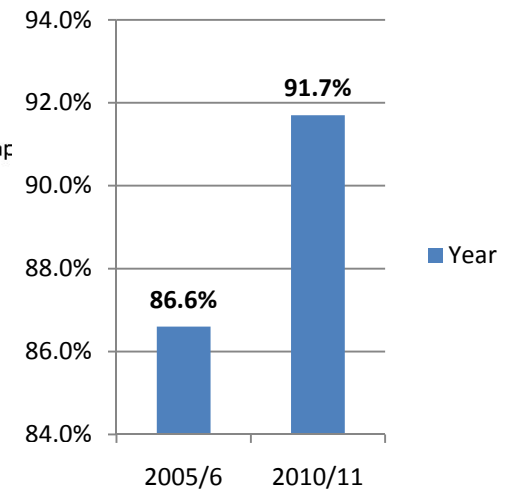

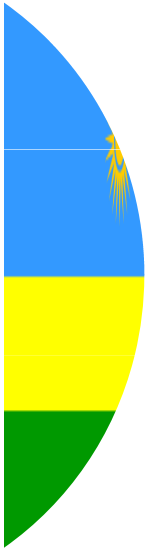

Net primary enrolment

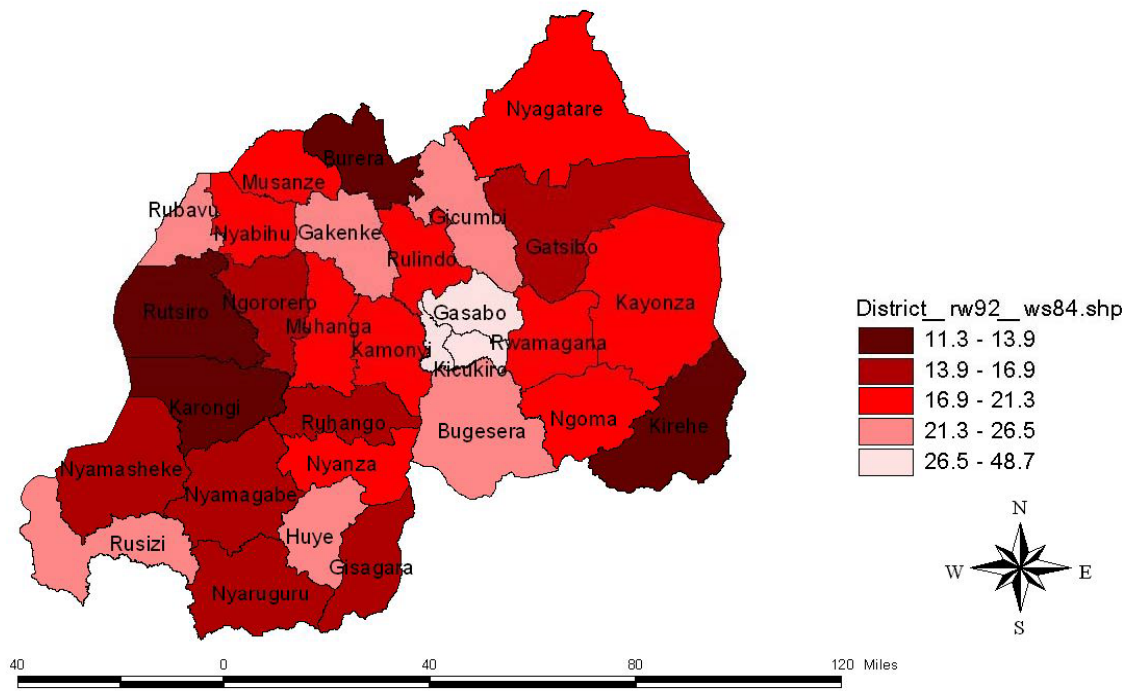




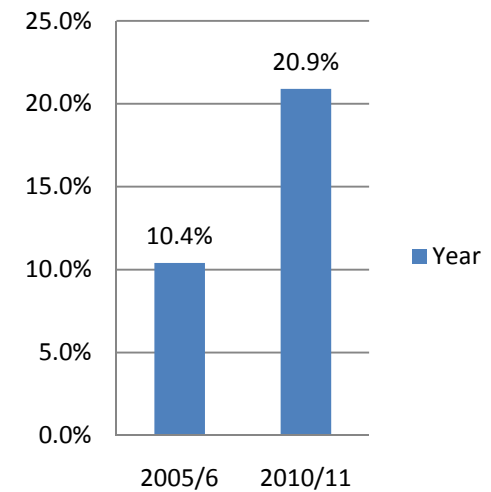

- % Net secondary school attendance, EICV3: Overall 20.9%.



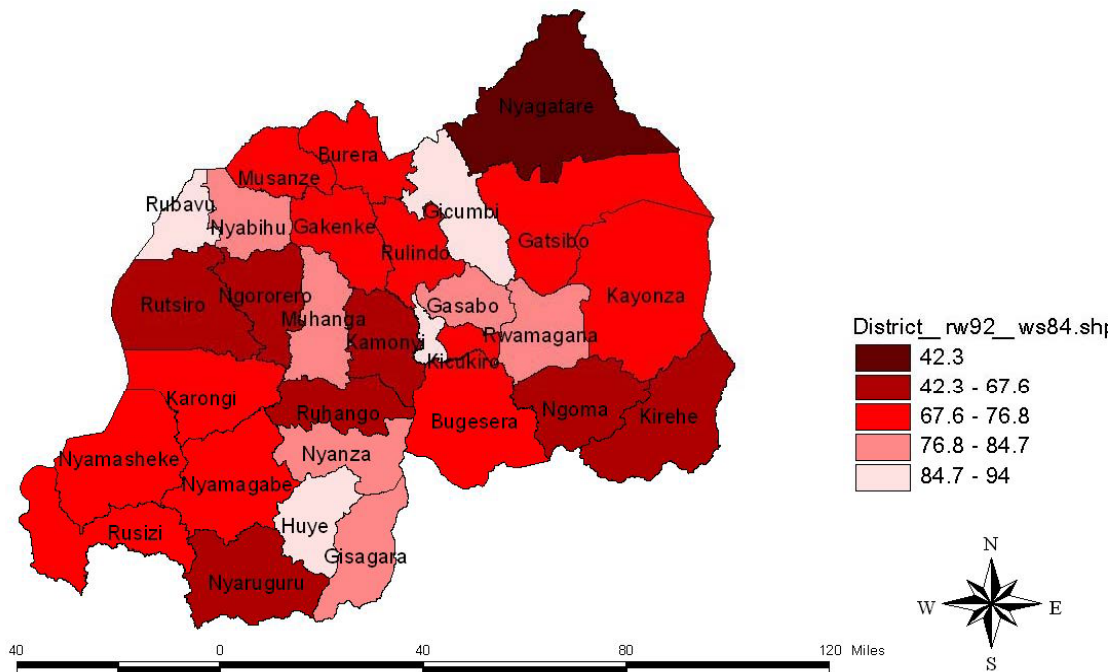
Net secondary enrolment



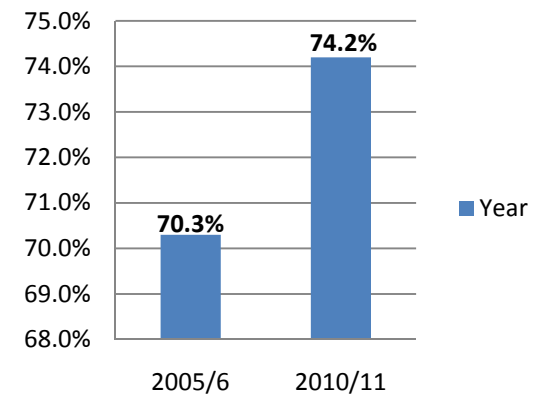

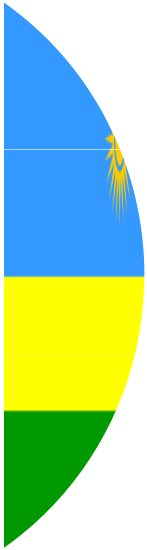

% with safe drinking water

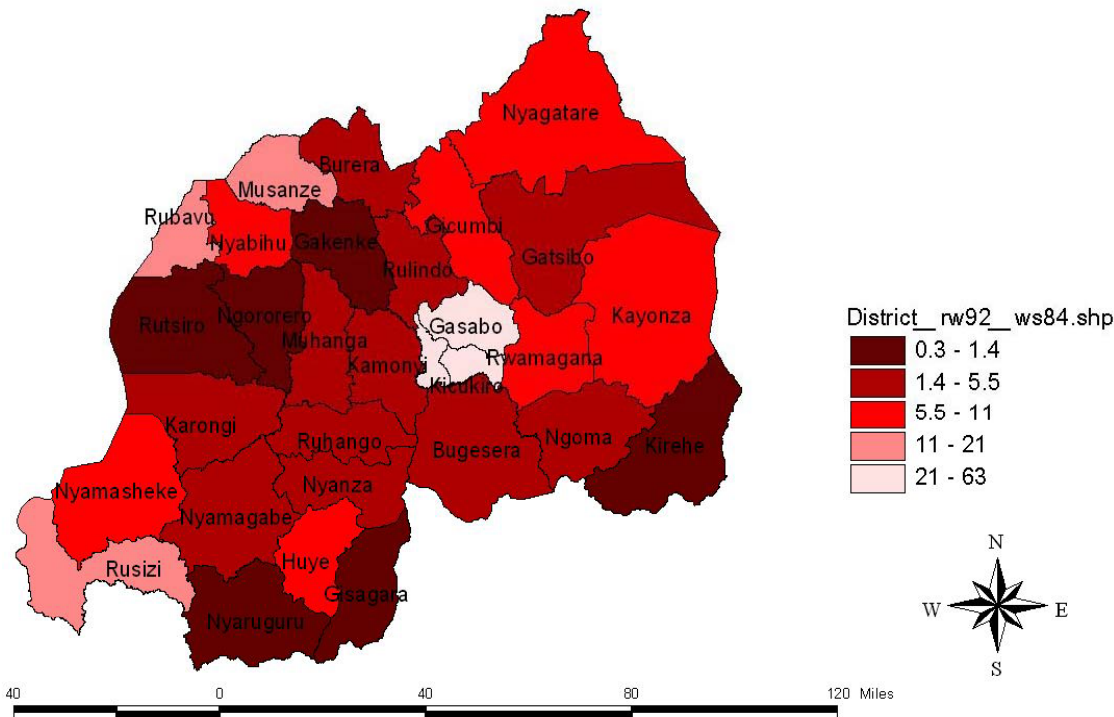




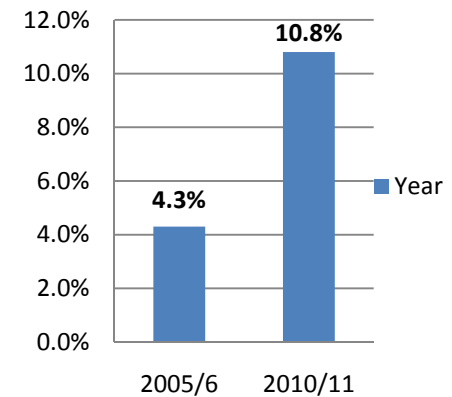

- % with electricity for lighting, EICV3: Overall 10.8%.



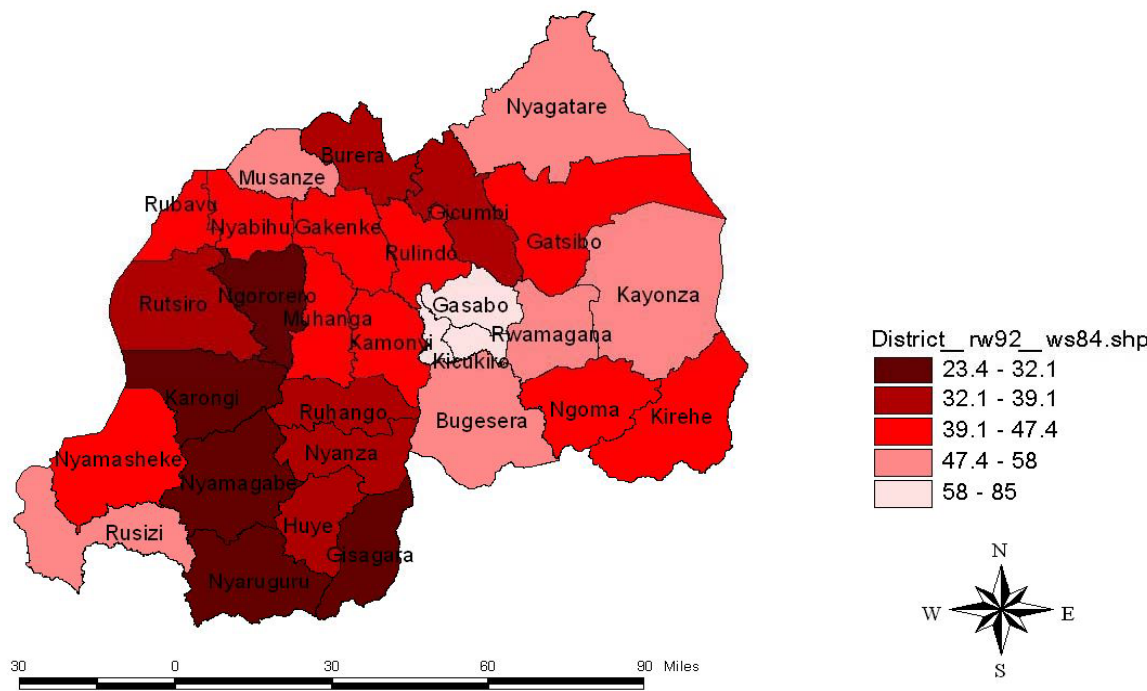
% of households with electricity



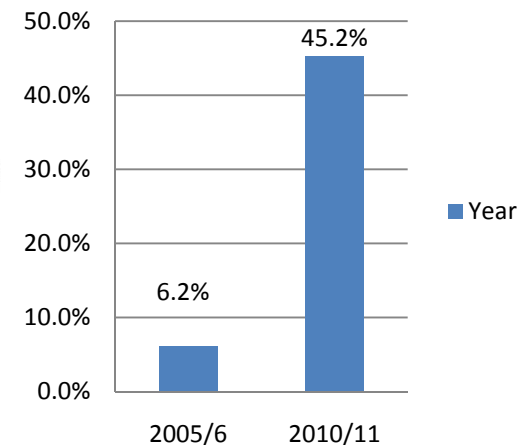

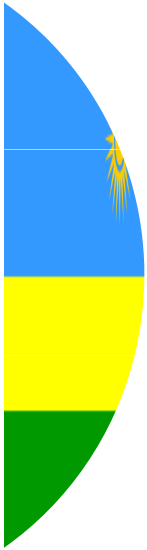

% Owning a mobile phone



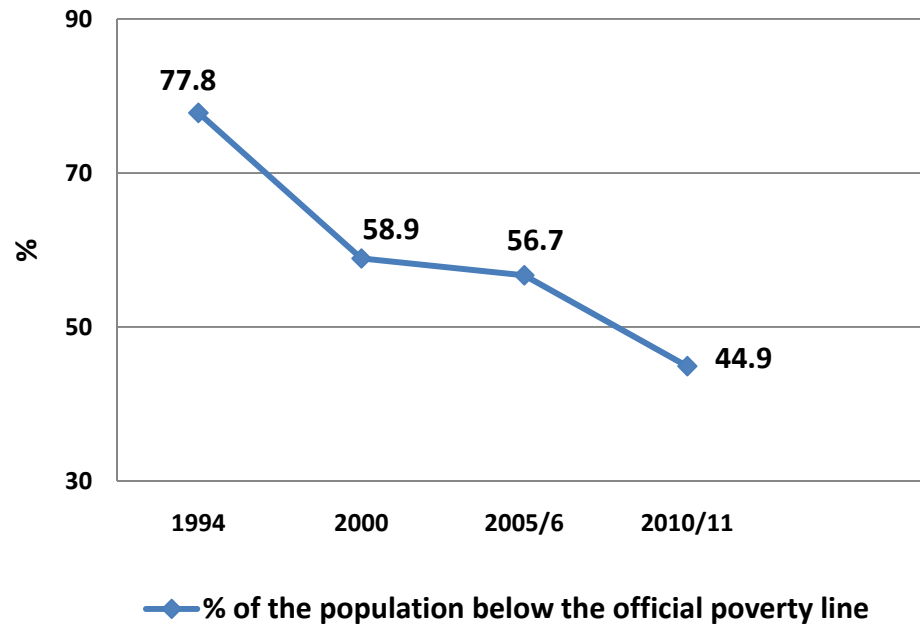

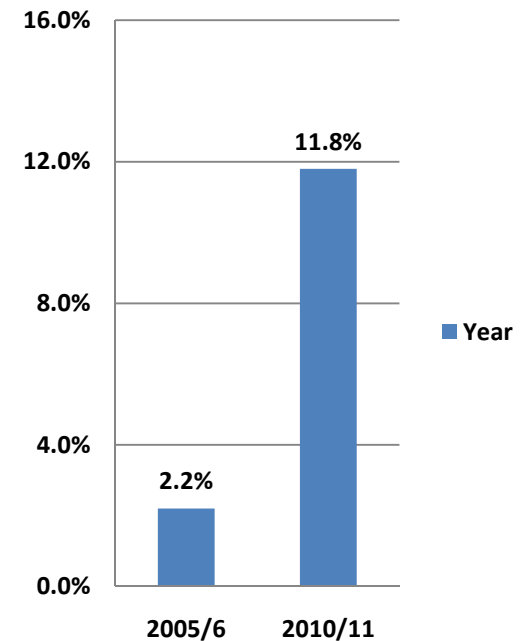

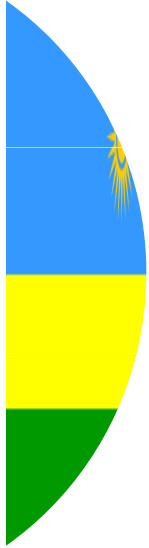
- Poverty: Target EPRS1 in 2012 is 46%

% poverty reduction

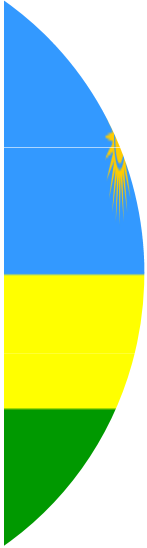

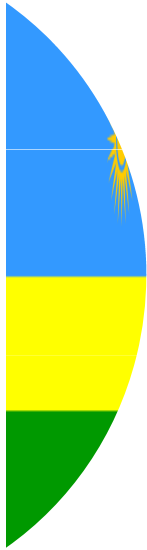

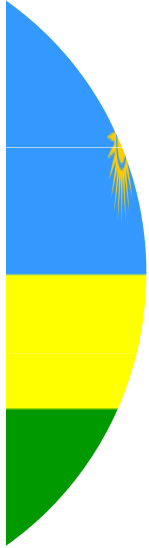
- Poverty distribution by district%.





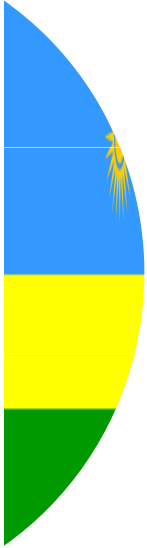

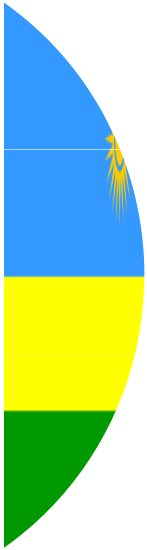
Reasons for improvement

- ❑ Improved agriculture production
- ❑ Agro business
- ❑ Farm wage employment
- ❑ Increase in nonfarm wages
- ❑ Income transfers (from family and friends)
- ❑ Slowing population growth



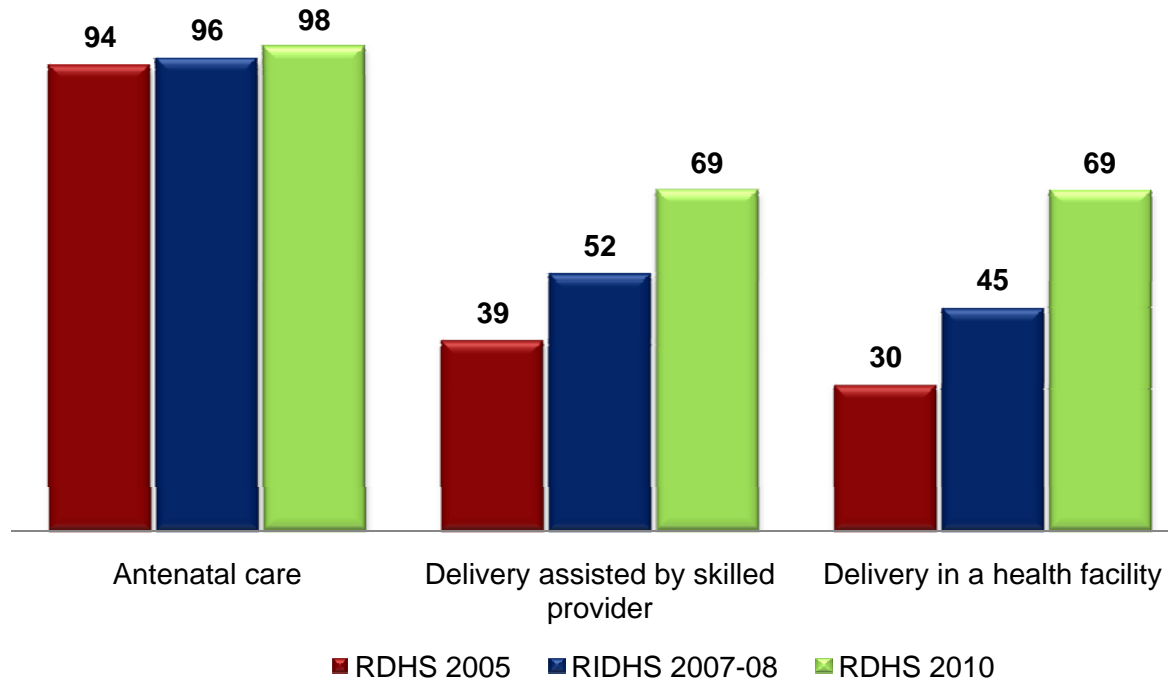
Challenges

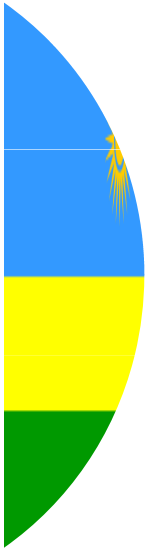
- ❑ Population growth

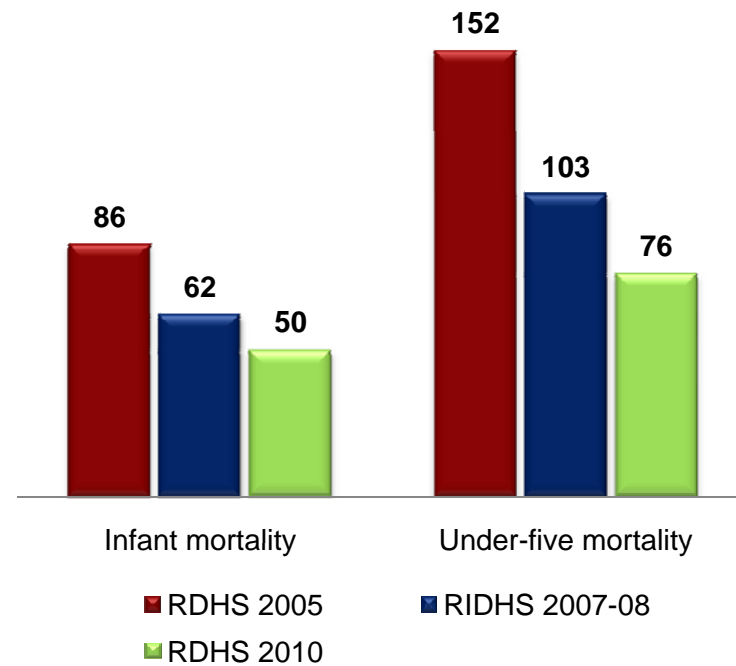
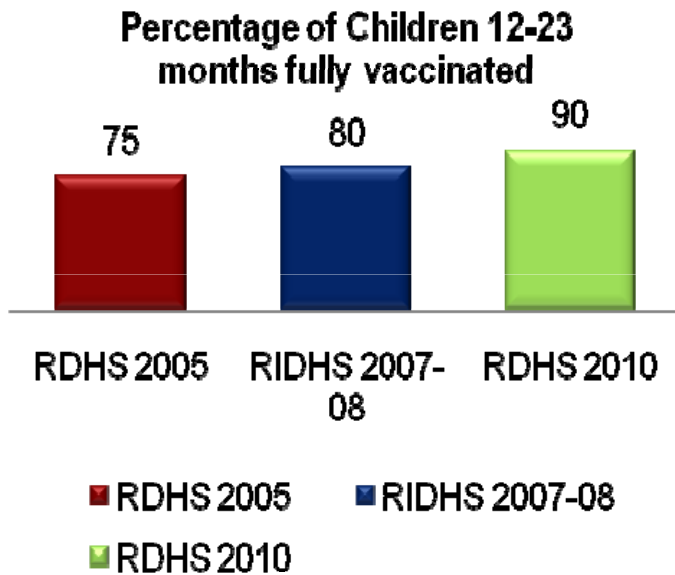

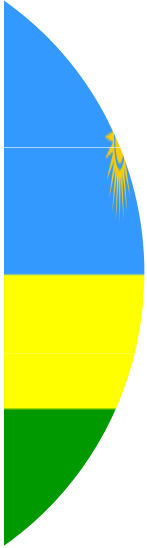

Trends in Children Health

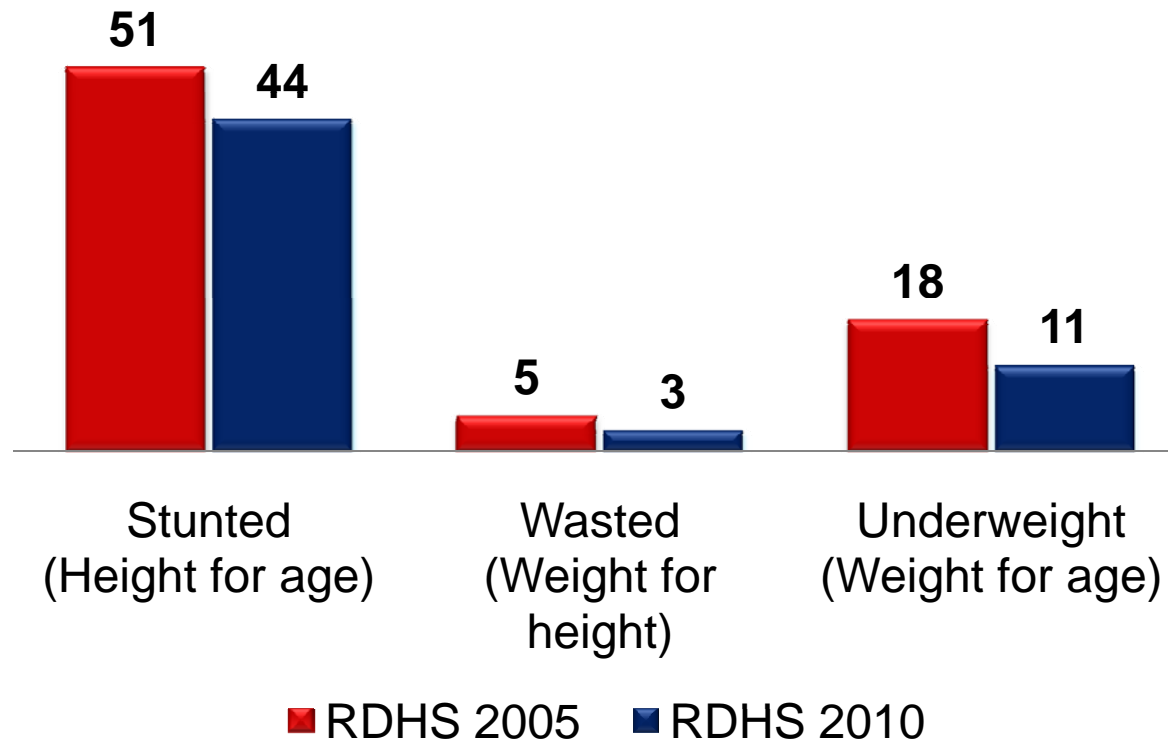


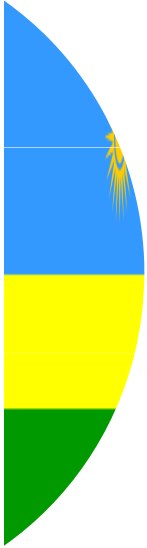

More than 2 SD below the median of WHO Child Growth Standards adopted in 2006.

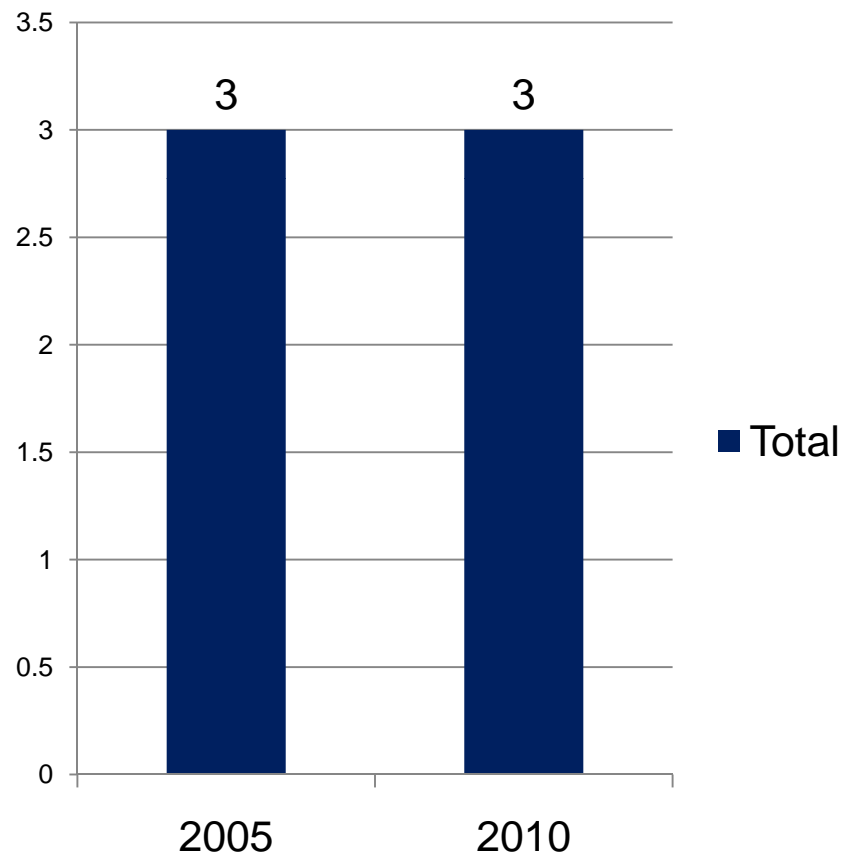


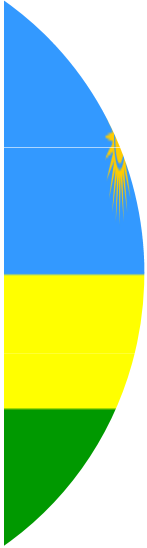

HIV Prevalence

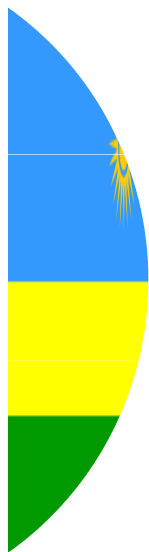
