



■ Average GDP growth 2006 – 2010: 8.4%




□ GDP per capita: Vision 2020 target USD 900

GDP/CAPITA (US \$) 2006 - 2010






% Net primary school attendance, EICV3: Overall 91.7%.


% Net secondary school attendance, EICV3: Overall 20.9%.





% with safe drinking water, EICV3: Overall 74.2%.




% with safe drinking water



with electricity for lighting, EICV3: Overall 10.8%.




% of households with electricity


% ownership of mobile phones, EICV3: Overall 45.2%.



Proportion of the population below the official poverty line 1994 - 2010/11






Reasons for improvement

- Slowing population growth


Challenges


- Population growth

Trends in Maternal Health




Trends in Children Health






Undernourished Children
