DAD Launch

- DAD completed and available online via:
<http://www.devpartners.gov.rw>
- Training of focal points at EFU/MINECOFIN and ICT complete
- Preliminary data in DAD from initial collection for DPM
 - Final data population essential to realise full utility, following launch

Near-Term Next Steps

- Incorporate feedback from Gisenyi on **Data Entry Form**; then finalize French translation of DAD
- ACU/EFU to carry out training to focal points
- User Names and Passwords created by MINECOFIN/EFU for focal points in development agencies
- Data Entry by Development Partners

Way Forward time-table

Training for Focal Points

- Data entry to be preceded by focal point training – 27 March 06 to 29 March 06

Initial Data Entry Phases

- UN Agencies & IFIs – 3 Apr. 06 to 6 Apr. 06
- Bilaterals – 10 Apr. 06 to 14 Apr. 06
- NGOs – 17 Apr. 06 to 21 Apr. 06
- MINECOFIN (Review)

Ensuring Integrity of Data

- This phased data entry approach is designed to minimise the danger of double counting
- Development Partners should check existing project entries before entering a new project
- DAD Administrators can define editing rights per user to prevent unauthorized creation, modification or deletion of data
- Defined focal points within agencies, assigned by MINECOFIN, will be the only users able to enter data

Expected Outputs

- Final DAD Data Entry Form
 - To be agreed upon by stakeholders to facilitate the upcoming data entry exercise
- Agreed frequency of ODA data entry
 - Stakeholders should adhere to the data entry frequency agreed upon during the discussions
